Bishop Richard J. Sklba

Born in Racine to Stephen and Ann Sklba, Bishop Richard J. Sklba has three siblings, William Sklba, Kathryn Wegner and Paul Sklba. He attended Hansche Public Grade School and St. Catherine High School, both located in Racine. He received his priestly formation from Saint Francis Minor Seminary, the North American College, Pontifical Biblical Institute, and the University of St. Thomas Aquinas, all in Rome. He was ordained to the priesthood Dec. 20, 1959, at the chapel of the North American College in Rome.

Bishop Sklba began his priestly ministry as an associate pastor at St. Mary, Elm Grove, 1960-1962. He continued his ministry as a lecturer in the Old Testament at Loyola University, Chicago, 1964-1965; celebrated weekend Masses at




